Scholarship for the Japan-America Student Conference

From **August 1-23, 2019**, the 71st Japan-America Student Conference (JASC) will bring together 72 Japanese and U.S. students of diverse backgrounds and perspectives. The two delegations will study, work, live, and travel together as a group, visiting regions of Japan around the cities of Tokyo and Kyoto.

The conference is conducted in English. Student delegates will join roundtables to discuss such topics as sustainability, mental health, religion, education, and innovation. They will also tour and learn together about each of their host cities.



The Matsudaira Scholarship covers the \$3,500 participation fee for the program, including roundtrip airfare from the American Orientation program in Los Angeles. Applicants would need to cover the cost of roundtrip airfare to Los Angeles.

Matsudaira Scholarship applicants should apply directly to JASC. In order to be considered for the scholarship, a copy of the application materials should be delivered to CEAS by the Dec. 31 deadline.
